

CONDENSATION

Ways to prevent it

COOKING

Always cook with pan lids on and turn the heat down once the water has boiled to reduce steam.



BATHROOM

Close doors – After a shower or bath, always keep the door closed for a period of time afterwards. This allows the bathroom to cool naturally and prevent steam spreading to other rooms.

Having the window just slightly open will also help prevent steam building up..



Open windows when cooking and using hot water in the bathroom to prevent steam build-up. Use an extractor fan if you have one.

HEATING

Keep your home warm to avoid cold surfaces and remember that it can take a long time for rooms to warm up.

It's better to keep heating on low than to keep switching it off and on.



CLOTHES

Try not to overfill cupboards, wardrobes and drawers so that air can circulate around the contents.



WASHING

Never dry washing on radiators. Dry clothes outdoors if possible or put them in the bathroom with the door closed and the window open or extractor fan on.
